



Dr. Hitoshi Nakagawa, National Institute of Agrobiological Sciences, Japan

Hitoshi Nakagawa received BS degree from Kobe University, MS (Fungal genetics) in 1975 and PhD (Cytology and breeding) in 1993 from Kyoto University. He was Director of Institute of Radiation Breeding, NIAS (2004-09), and Director of Biomass Research and Development Center, NARO (2010-12). He has been working on cytology and breeding of tropical grasses, with developing 9 varieties of guineagrass, rhodesgrass, sorghum etc, as well as genetic researches toward isolation of apomixis gene(s) in guineagrass and biomass research. He was awarded Award of Japanese Society of Breeding in 1995 and Award of Japanese Society of Grassland Science in 2005.
